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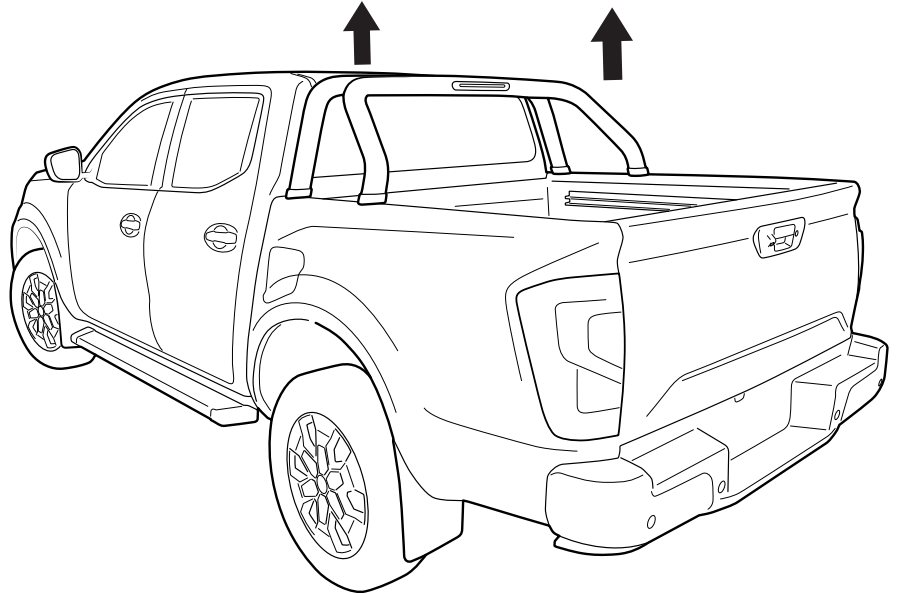
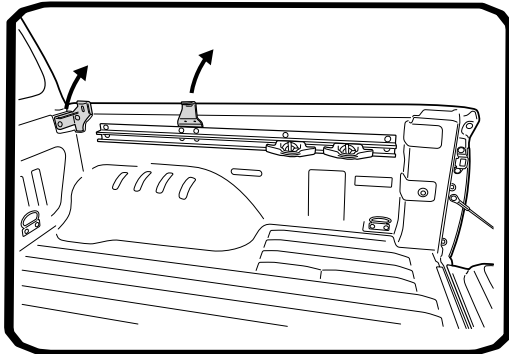


TUB PREPARATION

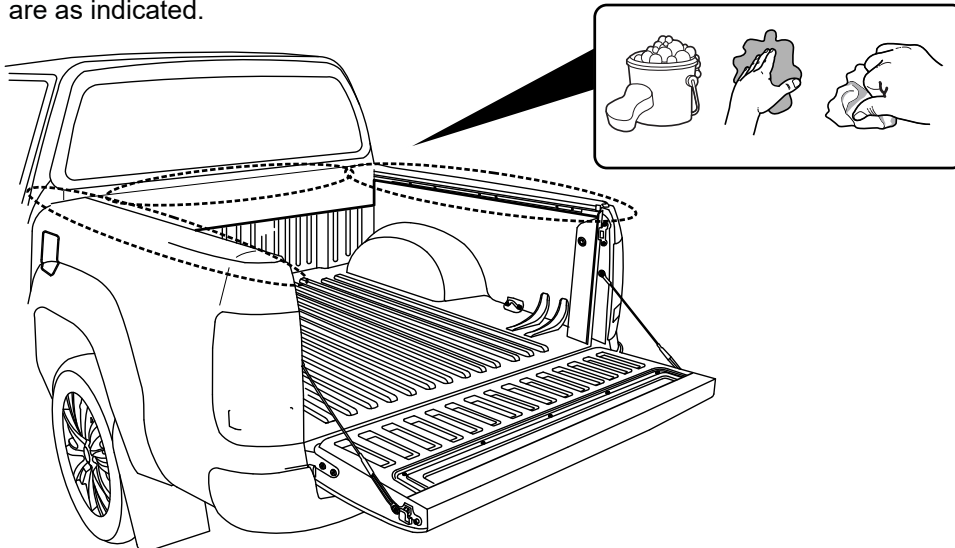
If the Vehicle is fitted with a sports styling bar, remove from Ute Tub (truck bed) including any bracket's holding it.



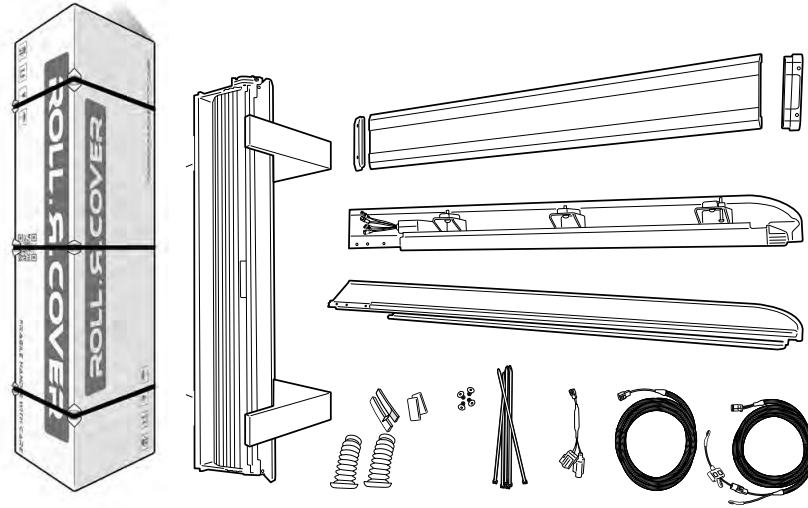

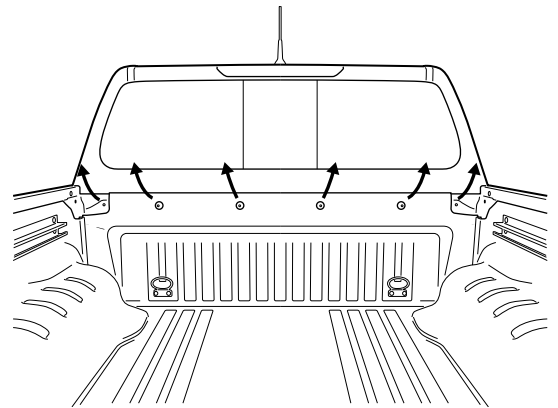

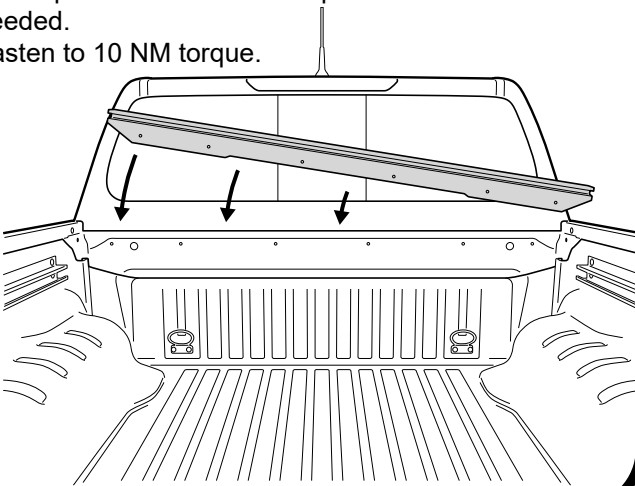
Carefully unpack the box.



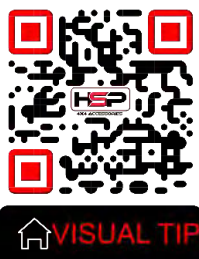
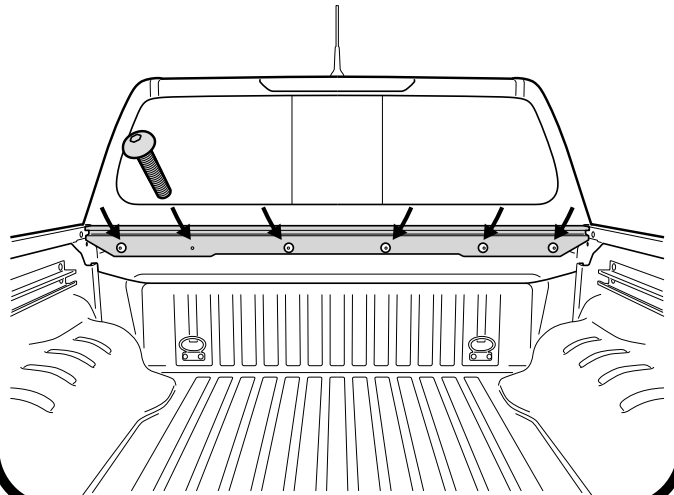
1. Unfasten and retain 4 factory bolts as indicated.
2. Remove factory grommet (left and right grommet and discard).



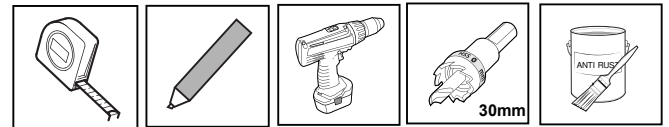
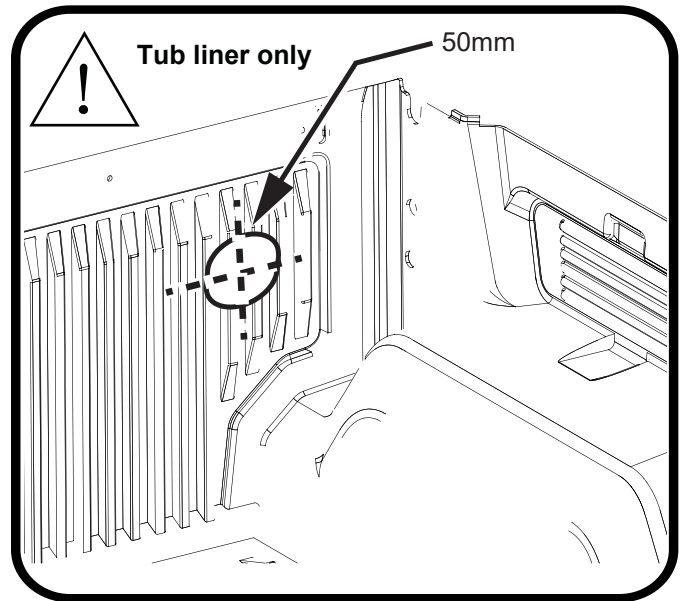
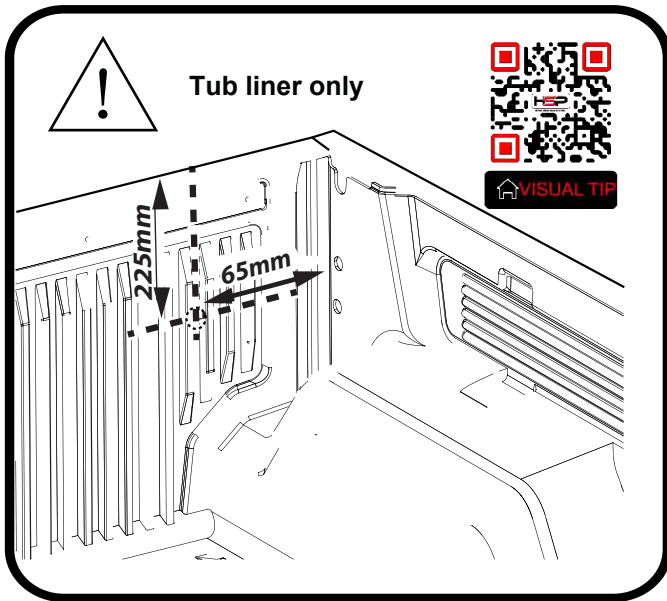
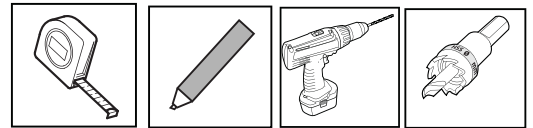
Place Front bar assembly to headboard and line up with factory threads. Note: If tub is fitted with factory liner, place Front bar assembly between head board and liner.
Push down on the bar while fasten using factory bolts where possible. M8 bolts are provided in the kit where needed.
Fasten to 10 NM torque.



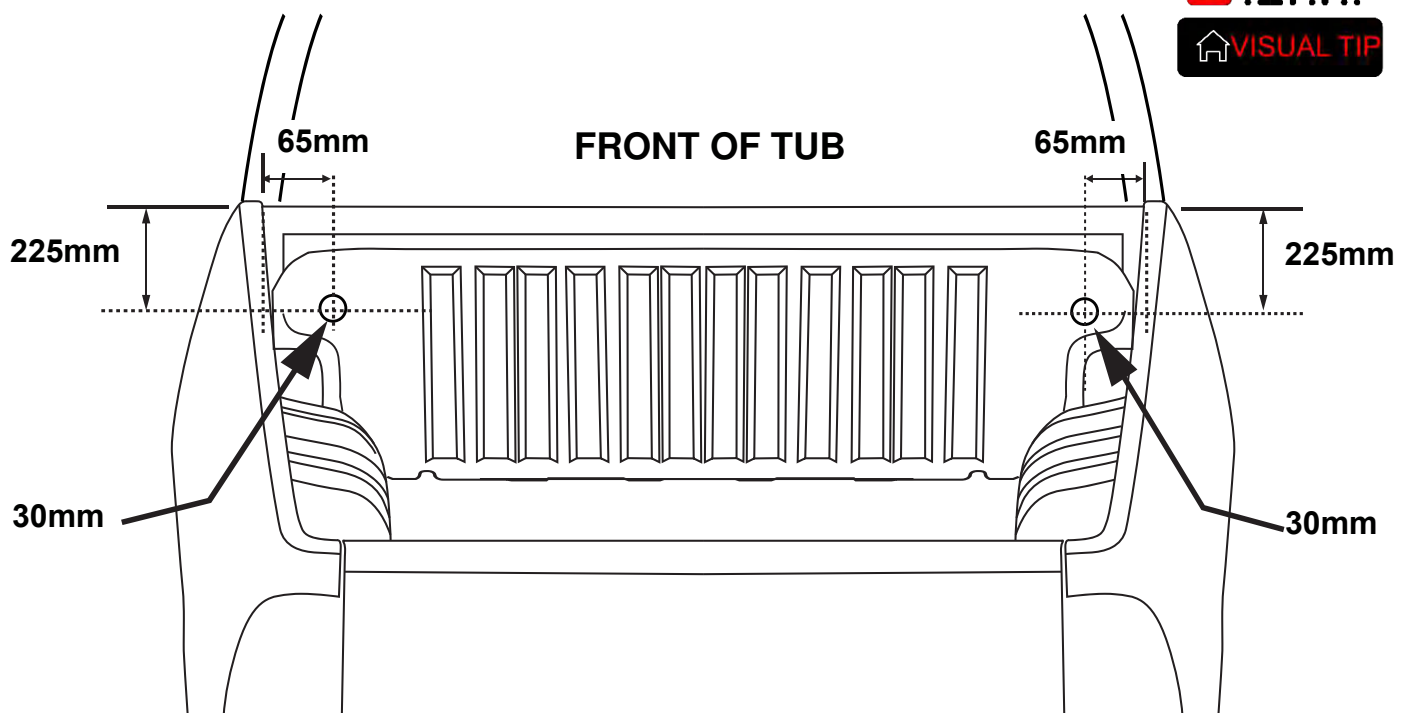
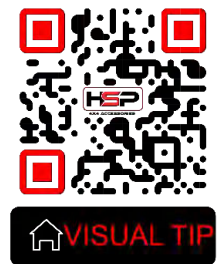
Fasten into position with supplied allen head M8 x 20mm bolts.
Fasten to 10 NM torque.



Measure down from top of headboard 225mm & 65mm from inside wall of bed liner as shown. Repeat to the other side.
Using a 50mm hole-saw drill the liner only as indicated.



Measure down from top of headboard 225mm & 70mm from inside wall of bed as shown. Repeat to the other side.
Using a 30mm hole-saw drill through tub front panel, file away any sharp edges. Apply anti rust coating. Repeat to other side.



ATTENTION: Do not exceed 30mm hole.

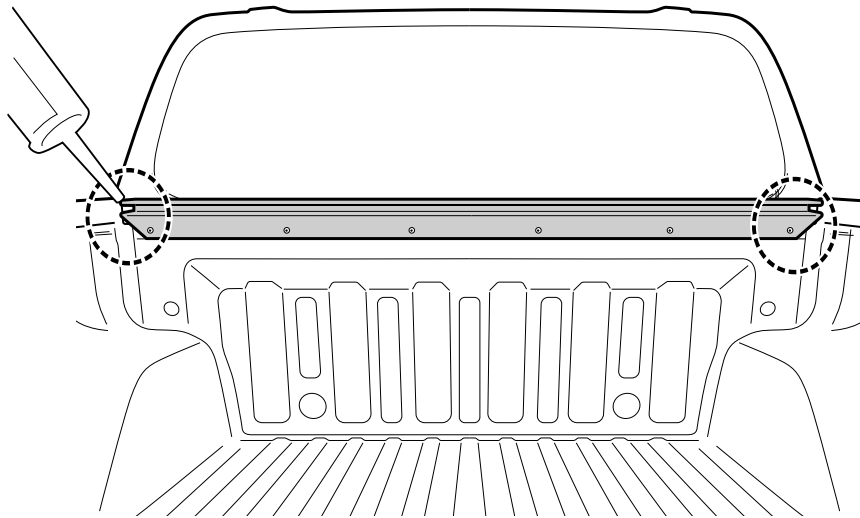
Sealing any gaps on the bed and FBA. It is recommended to use black sealant.

Apply an adequate amount of sealant to the areas indicated, then smooth sealant out.

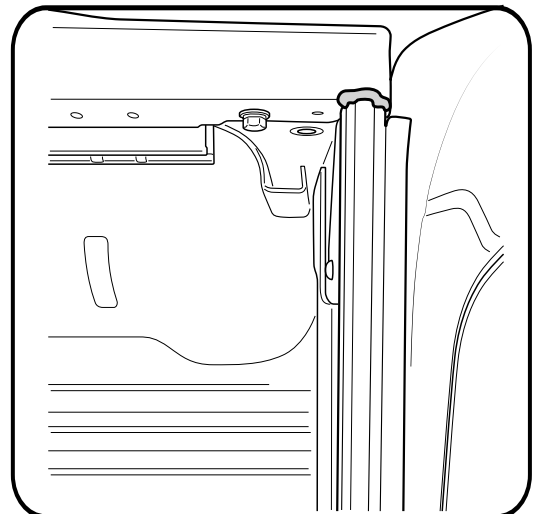
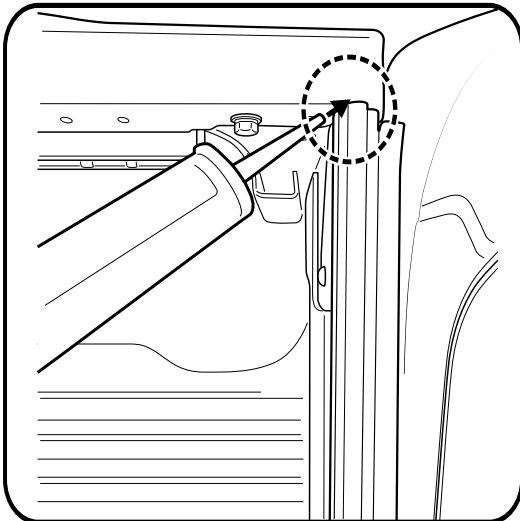
Clean any excess sealant. Repeat to the other side.

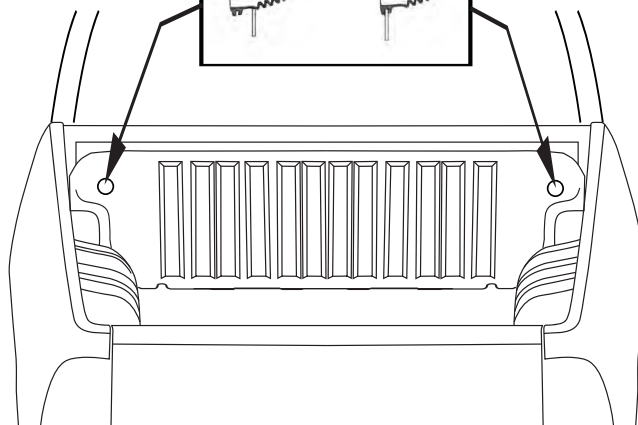
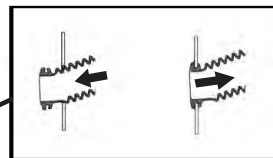

Install front drain pipes (55mm diameter end of hose) through pre-drilled holes on the front tub panel.



Note: With care push tube in.
Taking care pull the tube back so it seals correctly against the front panel of the tub.

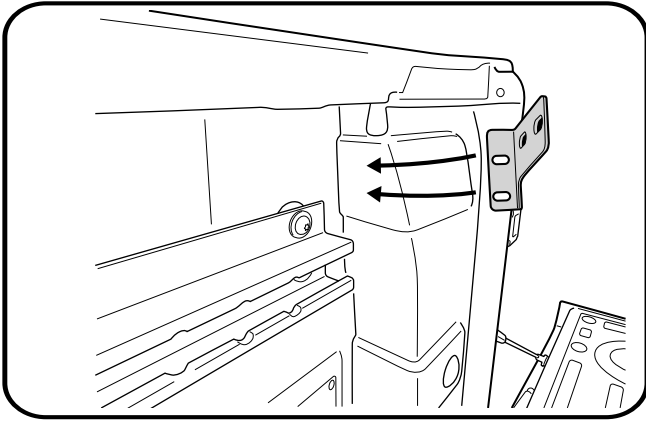

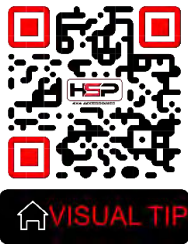
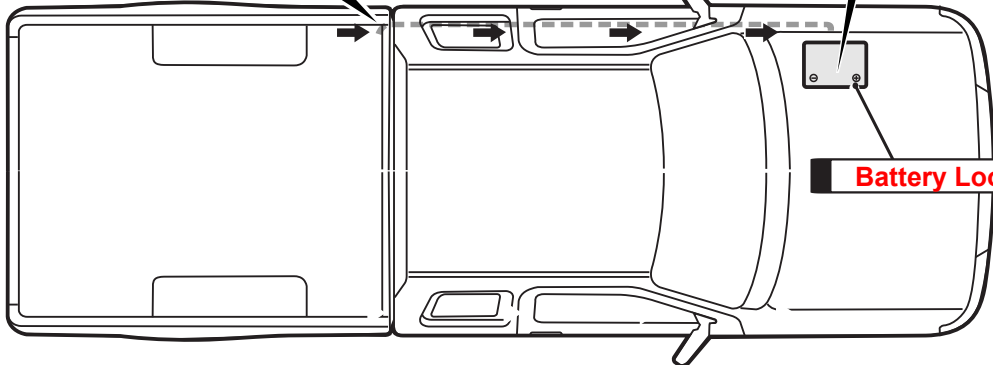
1 Feed Battery Loom S2.75 through the cavity*

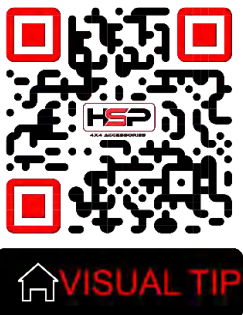
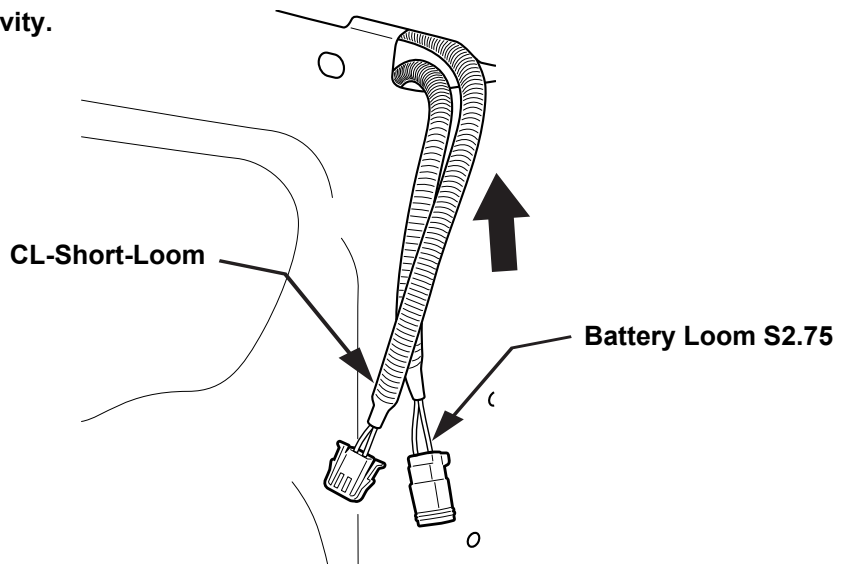
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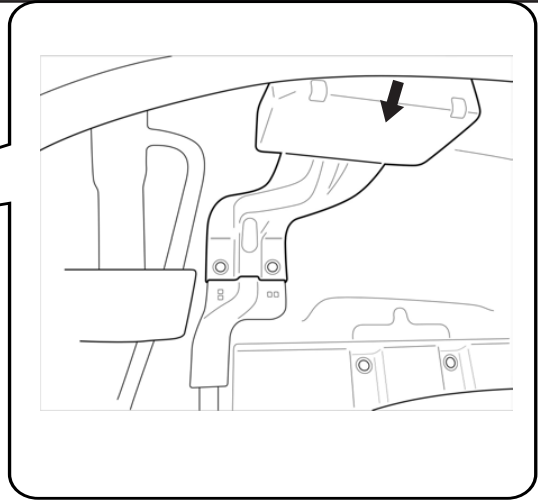
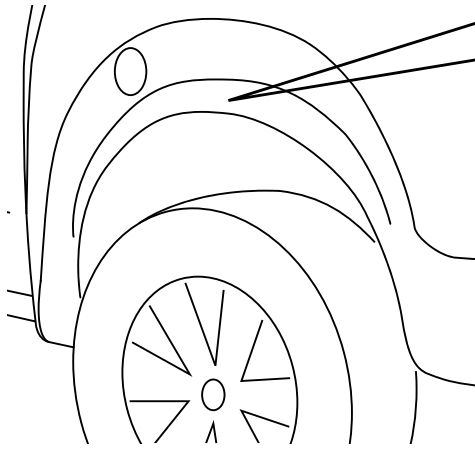
Run the wiring from the front corner cavity* (leaving 200mm in the tub) to the battery over the chassis rail. Making sure to keep away from hot obstructions and cable tie every 400mm. Reconnect fuse patch to battery loom S2.75, now attach fuse patch to positive of battery and earth to the body of the Ute.

* If limited room via cavity, locate any factory hole in the tub to exit. you may be required to enlarge or drill new hole.

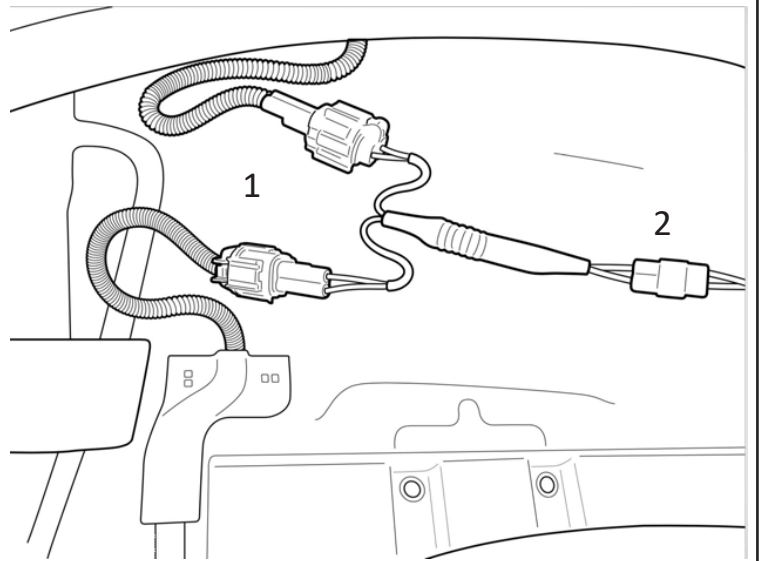

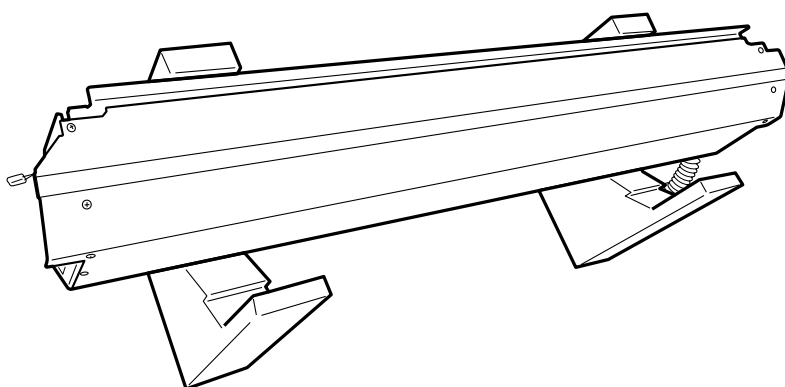
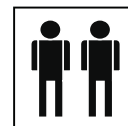
1. Clear area with non oil based cleaner, ie alcohol wipe.
2. Apply clear protective tape to left and right top corners of the tailgate as indicated.



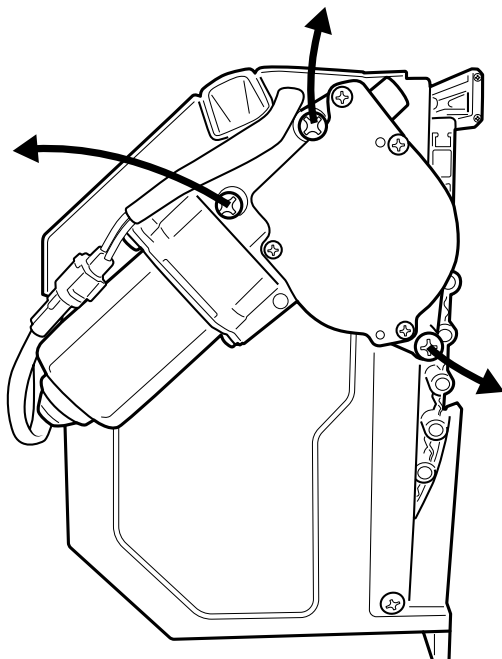

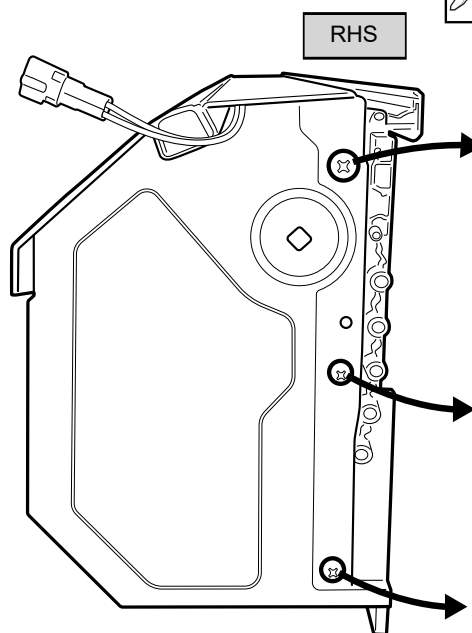
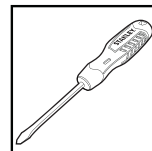

Disengage motor from the axle by unfastening the 3 Screw as indicated. Retain all parts.

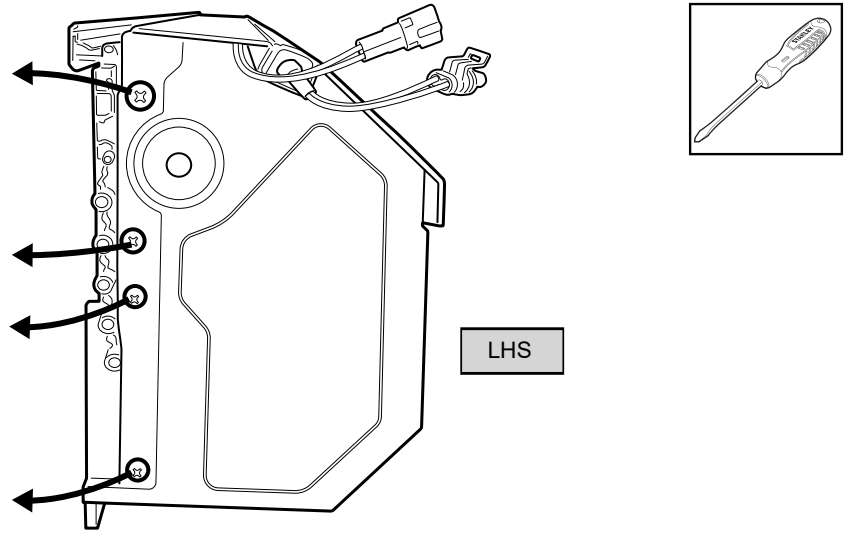

Now on the other side, remove and retain the 4 screws from the canister as indicated.

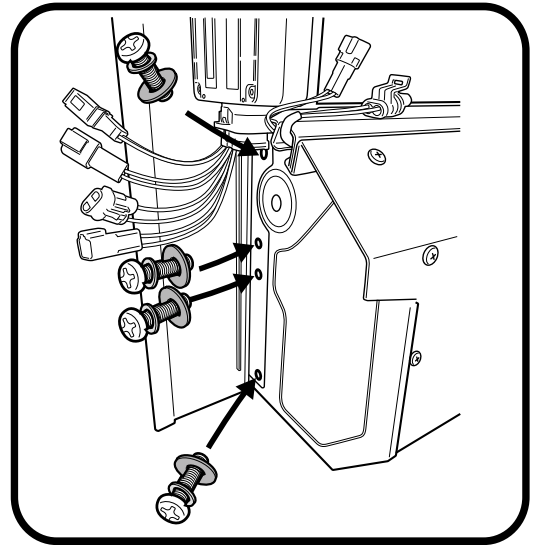
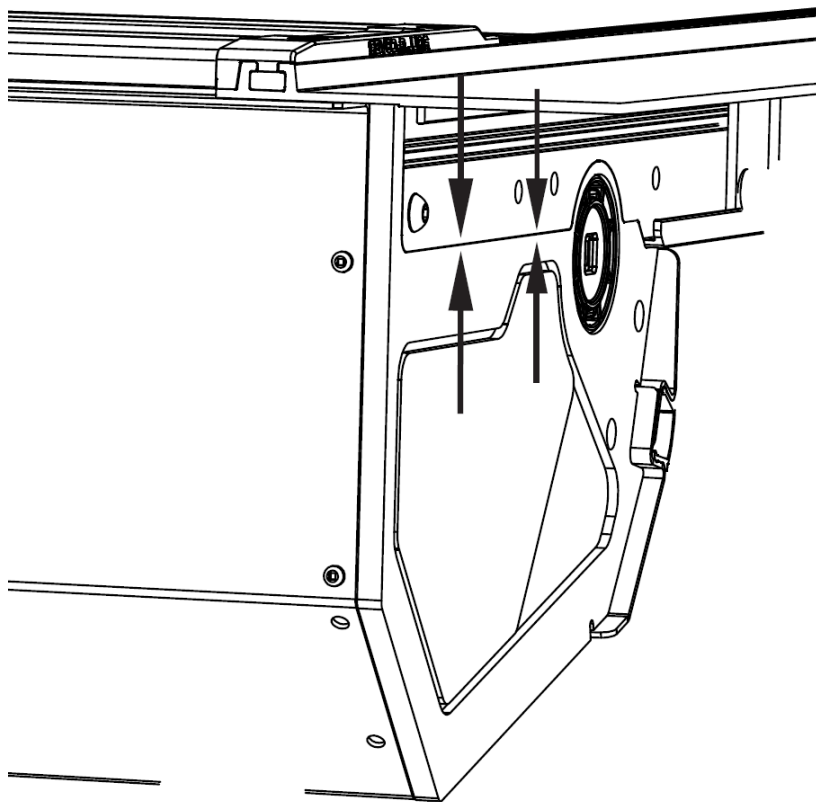
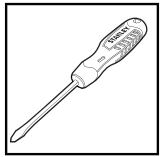


Align side rail to side of canister, guide the track to go in between the curtain end robber stop.

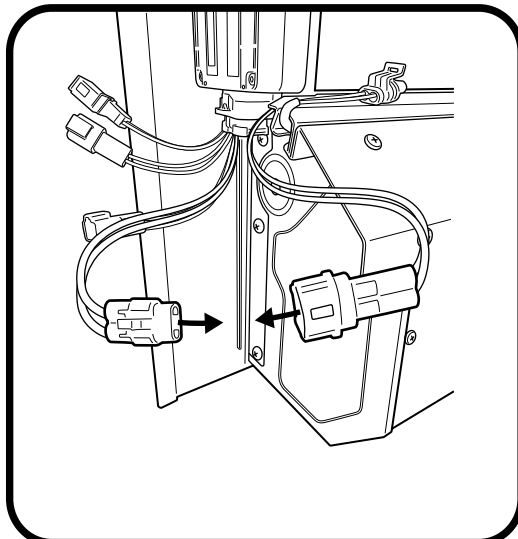

NOTE: Rubber bush orientation has to be as per image. (side with text on rubber, to face the motor).



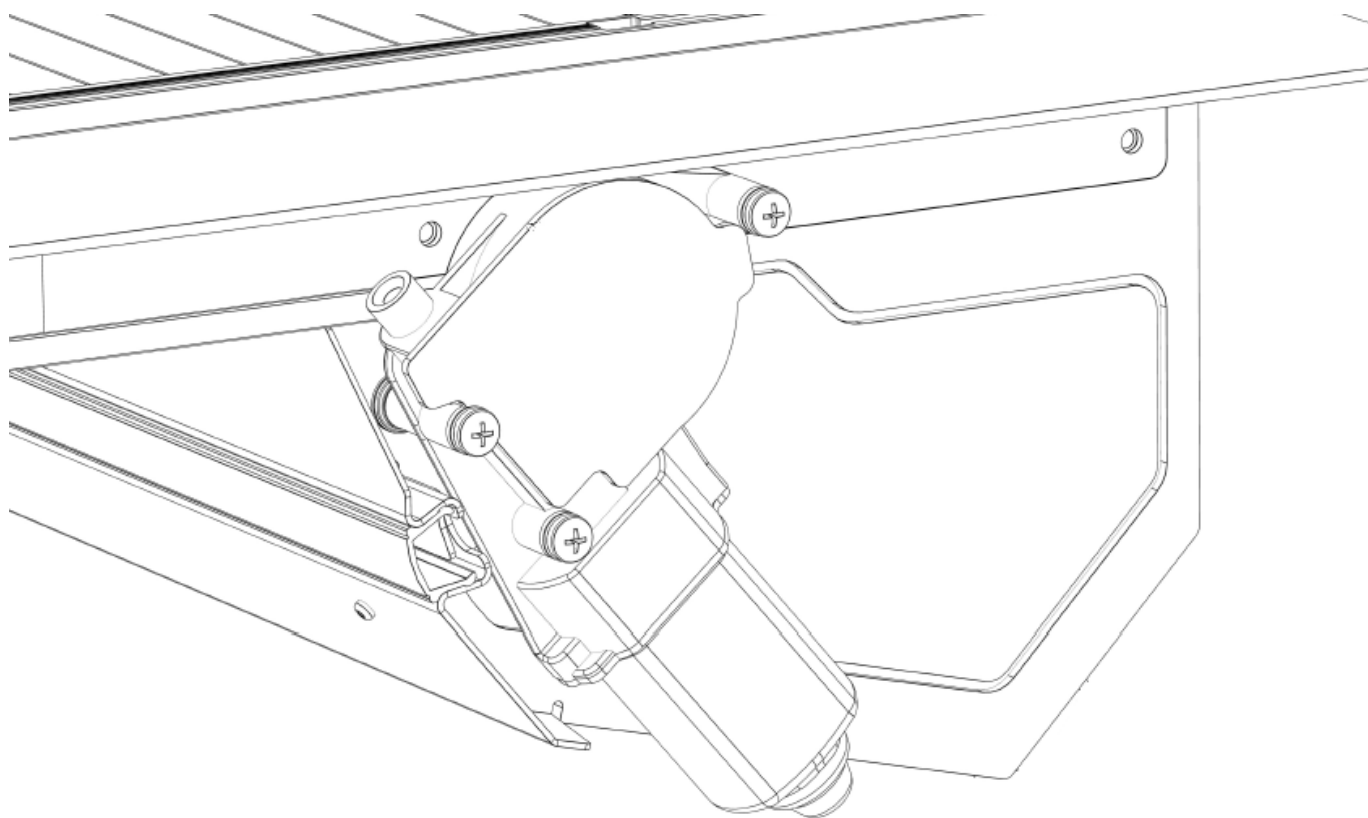
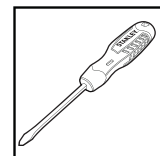

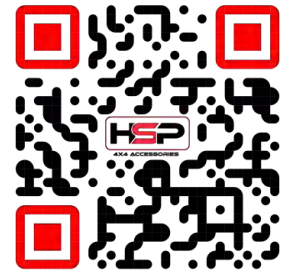
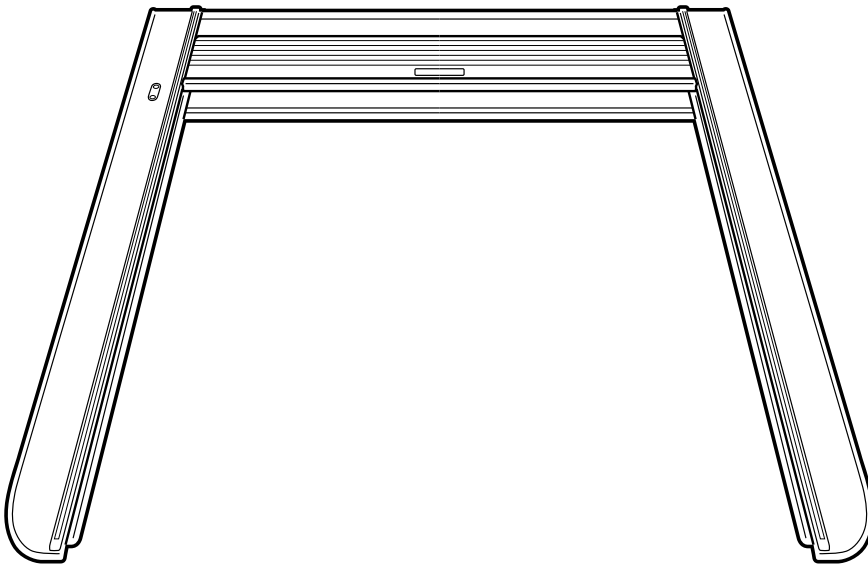
Fasten all 3 screws to 2nm torque. Over tensioning will cause operating issue's.



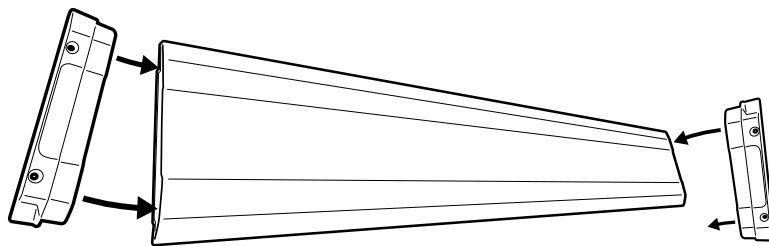
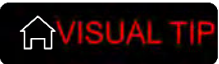
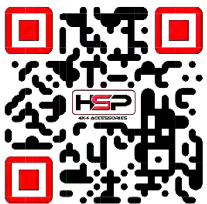
Motor is to sit level.

Any obstructions between motor and canister may cause operating issues.

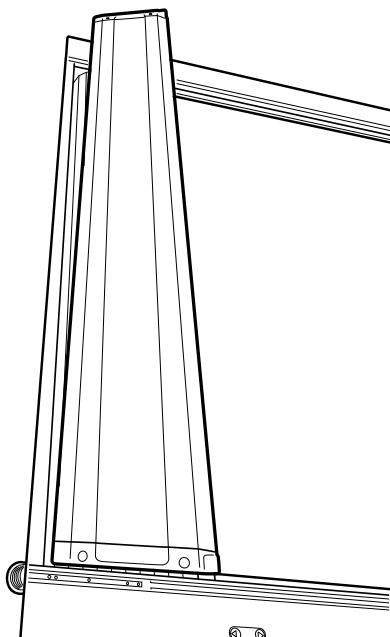

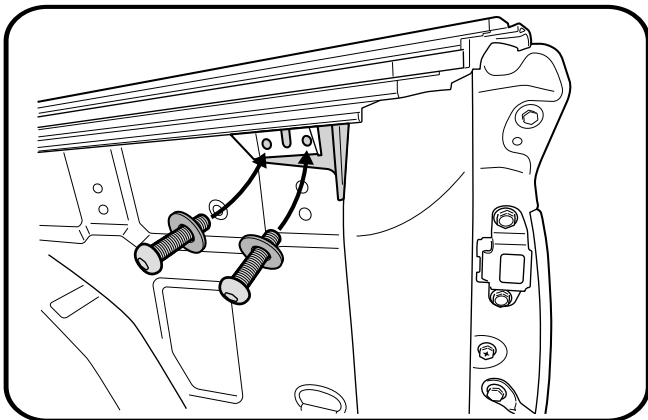
With care, pull out any side rubber
that has folded under the side rail.



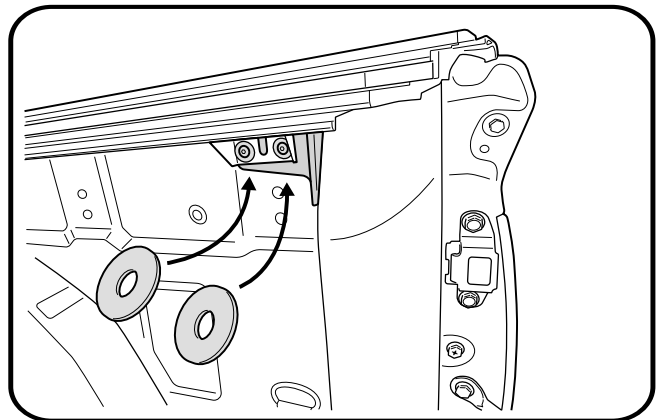
To the locations indicated below position clamp behind the inner top lip of the bed rail and the center elongated hole of the side rail mounting brackets. Repeat to other side.



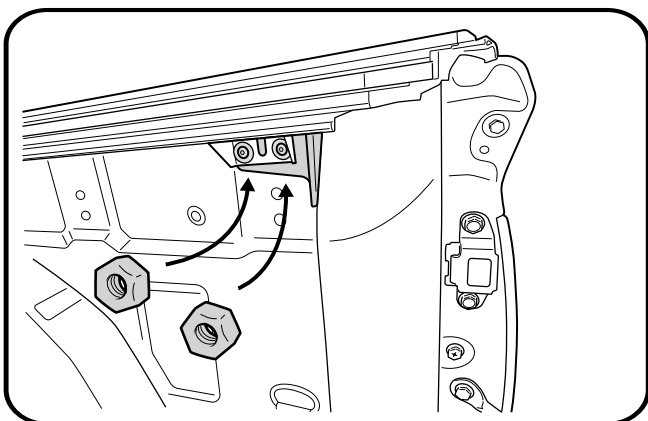
To the locations indicated feed M8x35mm button head bolt through M8 washer, side rail bracket and rear previously fitted tub bracket.



Place M8 washer behind tub bracket and through M8 bolt.



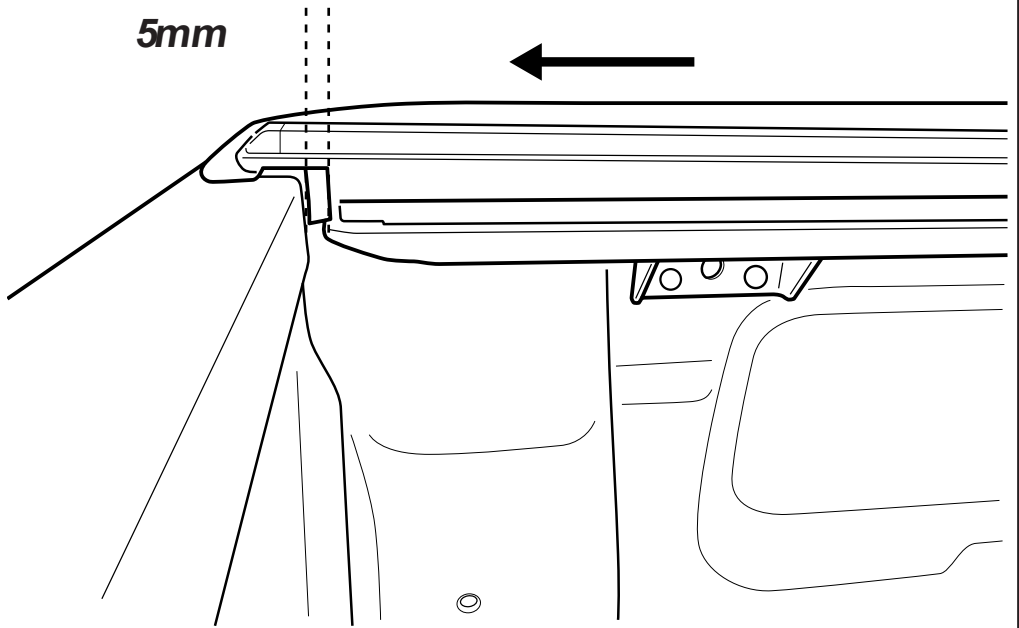

With the tailgate up (Closed position), Pull left & right hand side rails towards the tailgate, stopping short by 5mm between tailgate and side-rail end-cap. Repeat to other side.

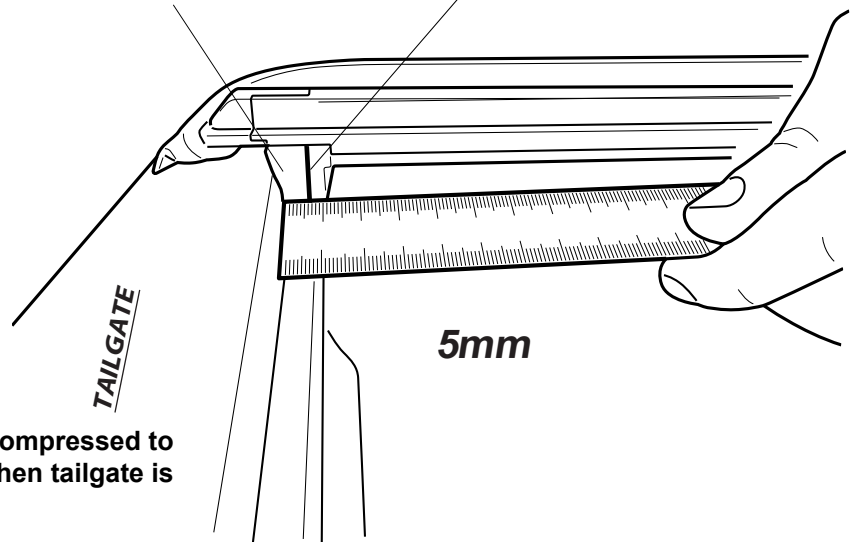

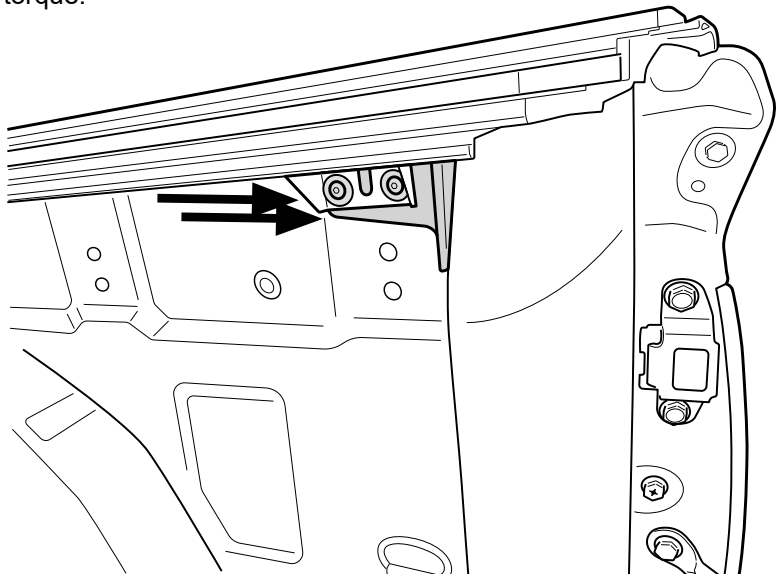

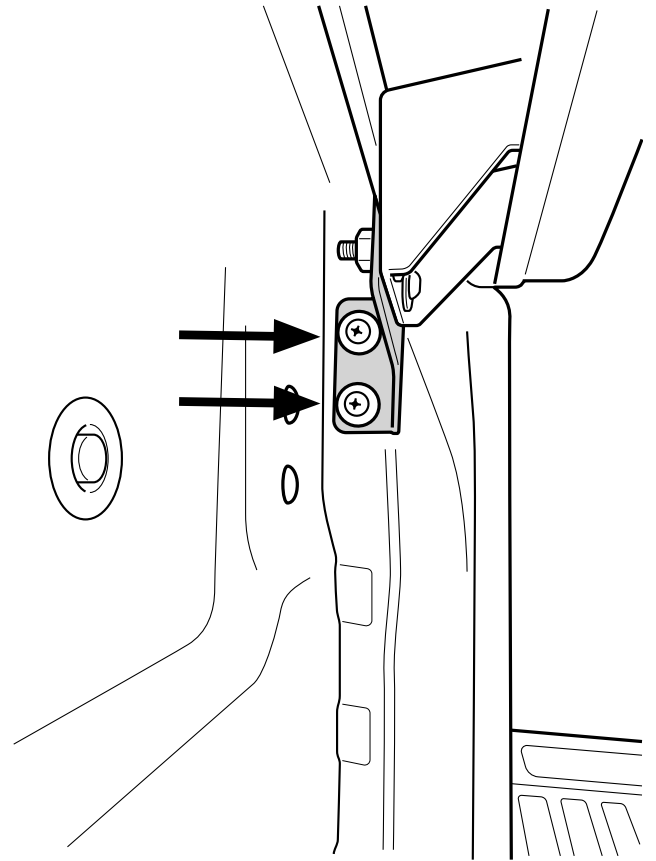
Fasten M8 button head bolt and nyloc nut to 10Nm torque. Repeat to other side.



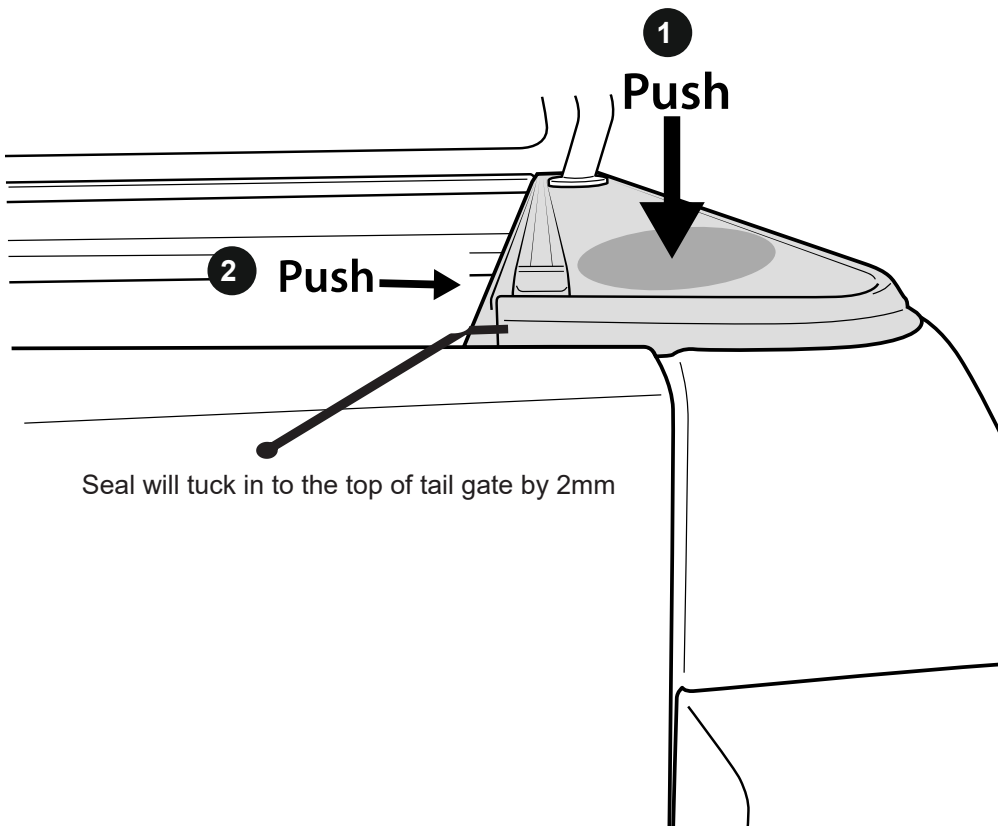

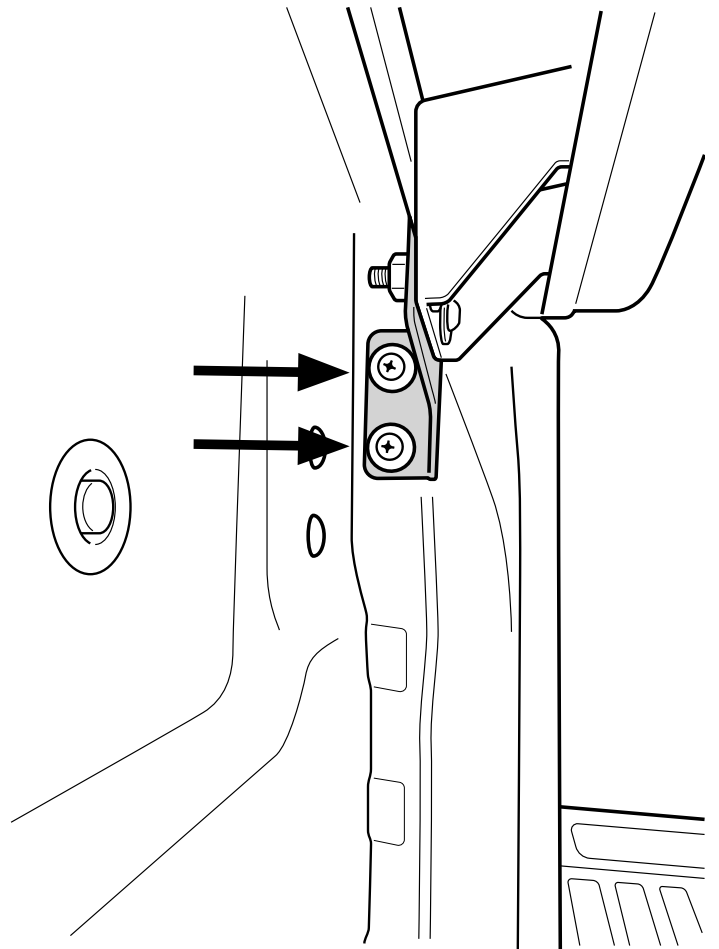

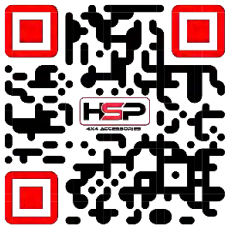
1. Gently push down where indicated so the side seal of the side rail folds on top of the tailgate by 1-2mm.
2. Push rail out as far as possible towards the outside of the tub.

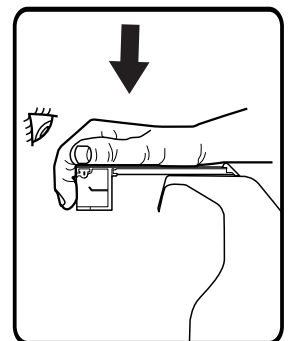
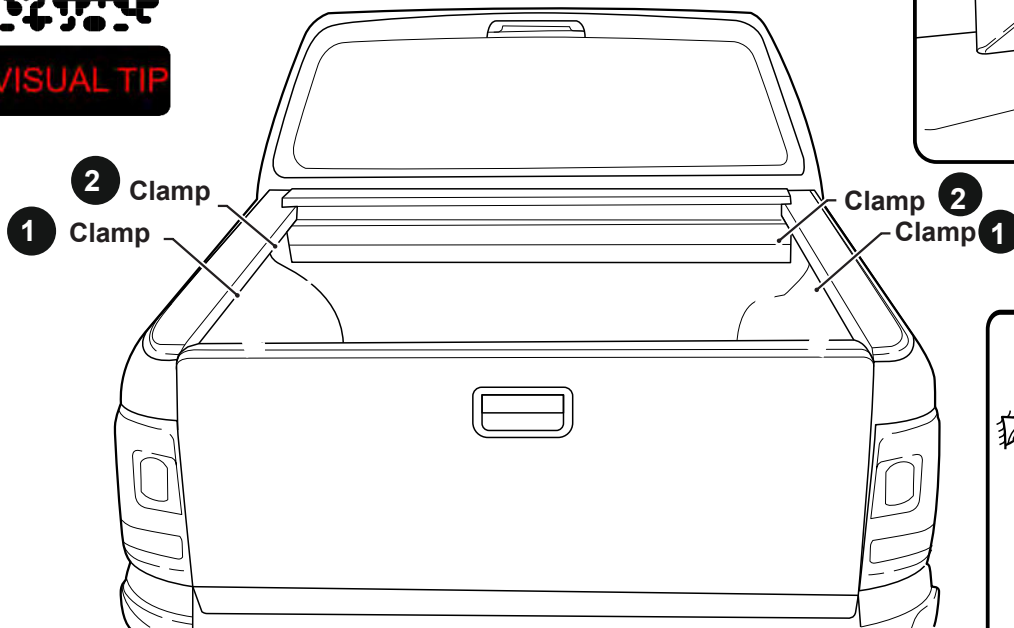
With position of side rail held in place in the previous step, fasten the indicated button head bolts to 6Nm torque.



1. Apply downward pressure on side rails.
2. Lift **clamp** all the way up or as far up as possible then fasten clamp to 10Nm torque in the order indicated below.



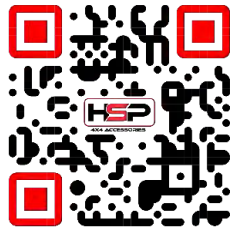
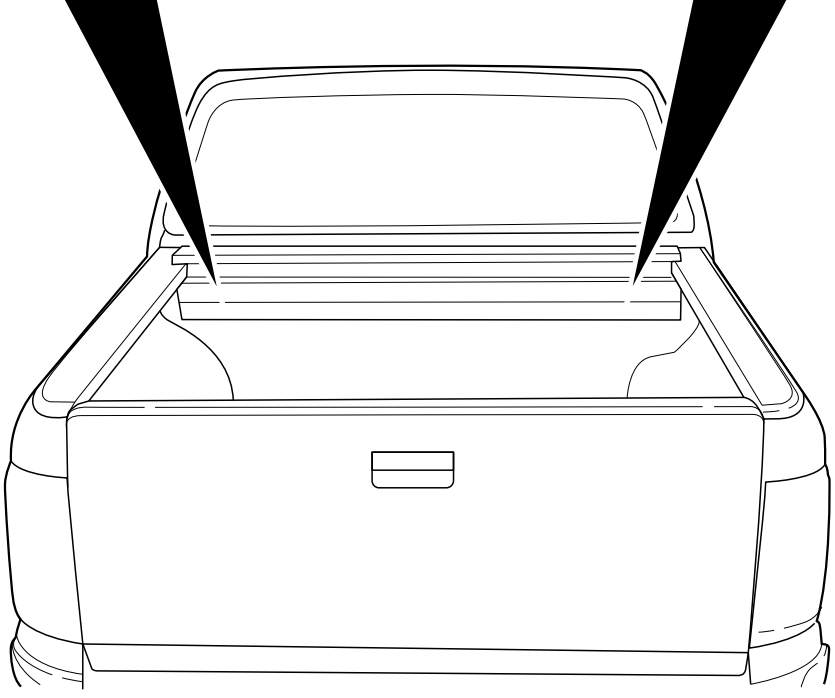
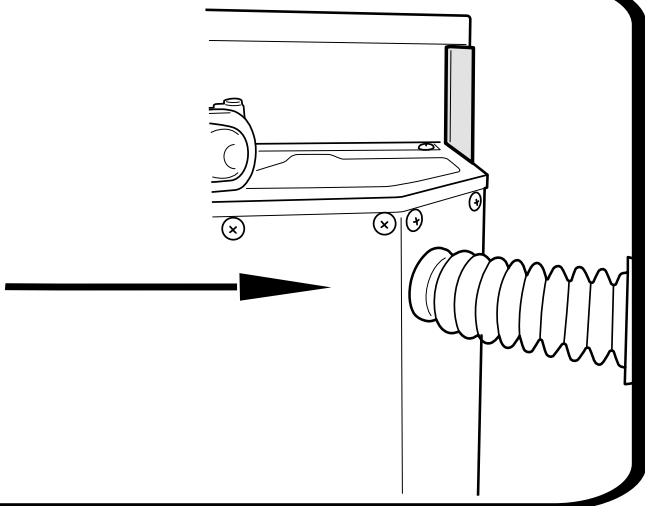
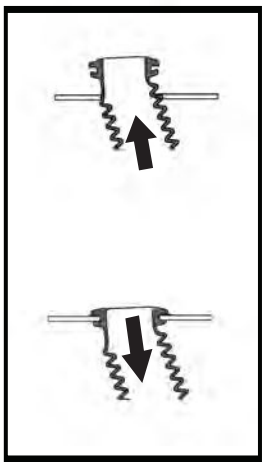

- a. Connect Battery loom S2.75 to Receiver loom.
- b. **Carefully** connect CI-Loom-short to Receiver loom.



Align connectors carefully to avoid pushing pins out.



NOTE: 1. To wear in the Roll R Cover please fully open & close the cover approximately 15 times after install is complete.

2. Set your vehicle locking system to unlock all doors with one press of the factory remote unlock button. This setting can be found in your vehicle settings.

Operating instructions:

Press unlock on vehicle key fob to activate controller.

When vehicle is unlocked the side rail sensor buttons will be active to control.

When vehicle is locked the side rail sensor buttons will be inactive.

Using factory key fob to operate:

Pressing unlock twice on the factory key fob within 4 seconds, will activate the roll r cover to open. Pressing lock twice on the factory key fob within 4 seconds, will activate the roll r cover to close.

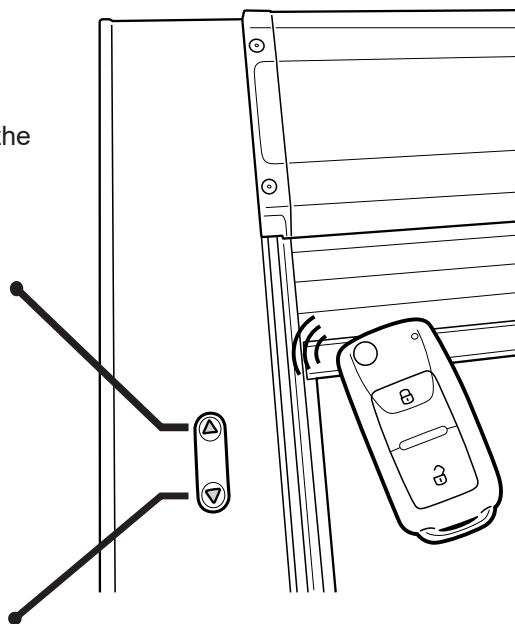


Vehicle proximity:

Tapping the proximity twice to open or lock the car door will act exactly the same way as the key fob being pressed twice.

Touch & let go to open, touch & let go again to pause.

Touch & let go to close, touch & let go again to pause.

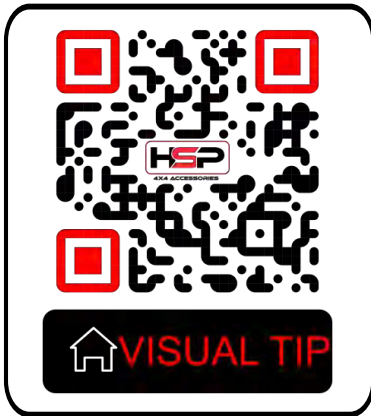

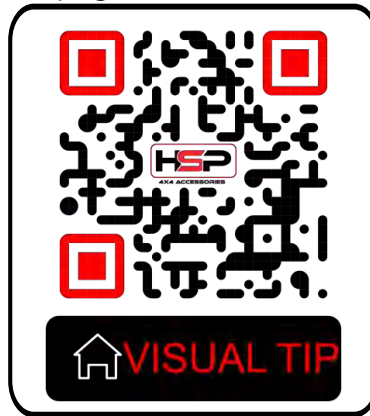
